- 1 Do the error messages on SFARMSG include an entry for linked course errors?
  - a. Yes, the error type is "LINK" and the baseline message is: *Linked Courses Required %1%*
- 2 Is HTML recognized by the browser when entered into the custom message area on SFARMSG?
  - a. Yes, and a new slide in the attached document will illustrate this.
- 3 What determines what curricula are chosen for the online Degree Application?
  - a. Curricula can be selected from the Learner record, the Outcome record, or either. On the SHAGELR form, you determine what minimal criteria will be required for the program or programs to be selected, including the source of the curriculum information.
- 4 Are there any major changes to AR for Banner 8 other than those associated with Concurrent curriculum Phase V?
  - a. Aside from the Concurrent Curriculum Phase V enhancements, there are only minor enhancements to AR for the Auto Refund Credit Amt/Student process (TSRRFND) and the Student Tax Report Process (TSR1098).
- 5 Where are the Incomplete Grade options for faculty available in Self-Service?
  - a. Grades are displayed in Banner Student Self-Service in the Final Grades page. When the Web Display (Indicator) on SHAINCG is checked (set to Y) for the rule, incomplete grades are displayed in self-service within a separate data block with the associated extension dates and the default, replacement, final grades. In Banner Faculty and Advisor Self-Service, instructors can also enter and override the incomplete final grade for the incomplete grade, as well as override the default date, if permission has been granted on the governing incomplete grade processing rule.

Are there any other new processes in Student 8 other than transcripts and catalog extracts that use XML import or export? There are other XML
- 6 processes in HR, FinAid, and particularly for Luminis, but for the student system, XML processing is available mainly for catalog extract and transcript processing only at this time.
  - a. SCRRIMS Course Catalog Extract - Used to extract course data and provide it in an XML format readable to third parties using IMS standards.
  - b. SCRCATE Course Catalog Data Extract Process - Used to extract course catalog data and create an XML output file for download or third party use.
  - c. SHRPESE PESC/XML Transcript Export Process Used to create electronic transcripts in XML format by producing a .xml file that can be read by the receiving institution.
  - d. SHRPESE PESC/XML Transcript Import Process - Used to import XML transcript files into an institution from other institutions.
  - e. SHRTCIM Transfer Catalog Data Import Process - Used to import an XML extract file of course catalog data into a Banner database and compare incoming records with transfer course records in the system.
